



English

In English we would like you to choose a story book. For example, 'Wombat goes Walkabout' by Michael Morpurgo or a story by Julia Donaldson.

Listen carefully to the story and see if you can remember details about the main character. Can you describe what the character looks like and can you give some details about the character's personality?

Use the word bank to help you choose the best adjectives to describe your character. Can you think of your own adjectives?

Once you have chosen your adjectives, we would like you to write a sentence describing your character.

Challenge!

You can begin to learn this story off by heart. It might help if you role play the story. You could act it out yourself or use toys at home.

Phonics

Use the phonics revision sheets to practice your Phase 5 phonemes.

Maths

In Maths we would like you to practice skip counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. To do this we would like you to colour in the patterns on a hundred square. Choose a different colour for each.

Once you have done this we would like you to describe the patterns that you see. For example, is there a pattern of odd and even numbers? How many patterns can you see?

Challenge!

What happens when you start on a number that isn't 0? Does the pattern change?

Theme/Science

Can you find and name the continents of the World? Do you know where in the World the UK is and which continent it is part of?

Over the next few days, we would like you to spend some time looking at and exploring maps. We would like you to achieve the learning questions above but please feel free to spend time on anything else that you find interesting! You may choose to look at the geographical features of the different continents, some of the countries in each of the continents and their flags, what animals are native etc.
