




<p><b>English –</b></p> <p>For your last piece of home learning, you were asked to plan an innovation of a story. Hopefully, you planned a new character and emergency for the story you were looking at.</p> <p>Now, we would like you to create that story, using adjectives (describing words), a range of sentence types with different sentence starters (then, next, suddenly, quickly) and conjunctions (and, but, so, because) to add more detail.</p> <p>We would like you to take your time and do this to the best of your ability so it will be your home learning task for Thursday too!</p> <p>You could write out your story or record yourself saying it. Either way, we would love to see what you have done!</p>	<p><b>Maths -</b></p> <p>This week, in Maths, we would like you to look at <b>division</b> as <b>sharing</b> items equally. You could have a tea party or picnic, with your toys, or you could share some real food with your family. How can you make sure that you have shared the items fairly/equally? Do you know how to record what you have done as a number sentence?</p> <p>Here is an idea to get you started:</p> <p><b>Can you share 6 apples equally between 2 people? How many apples will there be on each plate?</b></p>  <p><math>6 \div 2 =</math></p>
<p><b>Theme -</b></p> <p>This week we would like you to research and learn about Aboriginal culture and art. We would like you to tell us who the aboriginal people are, what their culture is and where they live. We would also like you to find out about their art and what they use to create it.</p> <p>You can present this in any way you like. You could write a fact file, make a poster or create a power point.
