

English –

We hope that you have all had a super week! During the half term holiday, we have been lucky to have been able to enjoy the lovely, sunny weather. For the first English task, we would like you to write some sentences about the different things that you have done over this week. You may not have gone far, but you may have done some interesting things. Remember to use capital letters, full stops and interesting adjectives (describing words) and verbs (dong words). You may also want to include some time connectives – *On Monday/Tuesday, then, after, when, by the end of the week ... etc.*

You could present this as a diary, comic strip, poster/picture of each day/activity.

What did you most enjoy?
What was the strangest thing that happened?

Useful spellings to practise – could, would, should, people, Mr, Mrs, beautiful, after, children, because.

Maths – Money

Over the next couple of weeks, we will be learning about money. We have already done some work on this in Year 2, so this is a chance to recap what we know and explore our learning more. Start by looking at the PowerPoint about recognising coins: <https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-tp-1254-faster-finger-coin-powerpoint>

Remember which coins we have: **1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1 and £2.** We don't have a coin for every number! If we wanted to buy something for 7p, we would have to use a mixture of other coins to make 7p, and there would be different ways to do this.

For your learning, it might be useful to have some coins to help you. You could use real coins or play coins, or print out the ones from the sheet (link below). Or, you might want to make some of your own coins to use, cutting them out from paper or card.



You need to explore using different coins to make amounts, up to £1 at first. You could make a shop with some of your toys, label their prices, and use coins to pay. You could draw the coins needed to pay. Try these prices: 8p, 16p, 23p, 35p, 51p, 75p, 99p.

There are links to two worksheets below which you could use to help you practise. You don't have to print them – you could write the answers on paper or in your book. The one-star * and two star ** pages are good practice, and the three star *** are more challenging, so you don't need to do all of the pages.
