

## Year 3 Creative Curriculum - Summer 2018

### English

During this term we will be covering these text genres;

#### Historical Fiction.

Children will be able to write their own story set in the Stone Age. Children will focus their writing on character descriptions and making comparisons between Stone Age and modern time.

#### Poetry:

Children will use a variety of sentence types to create their own poems.



#### Stories from other cultures:

Children will explore stories from different cultures and look at common themes.

#### Newspaper Reports:

Children will learn about how newspapers are laid out.

They will explore who, what, why, where, when information and how to write in paragraphs.

### Maths

- Draw 2d shapes and make 3d shapes.
- Recognise 3D shapes in different orientations.
- Measure perimeter of simple 2D shapes.
- Add and subtract amounts of money
- Measure and compare different lengths
- Add and subtract lengths/mass/capacity
- Tell and show the time to the nearest minute using analogue and digital clocks
- Compare duration of events

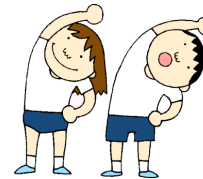
