

## Year 4 Creative Curriculum - Summer Term 2018

### English

During this term we will be covering these text genres:

- Fiction: Myths and Legends
- Non Fiction: Instructions & Recounts
- Building Characters and relationships
- Myths & Legends



We will be learning to;

- Identify and apply the vocabulary used in different types of writing,
- Identify the grammar used in different types of writing,
- Organise our writing into paragraphs,
- Use drop in clauses,
- Use commas to mark clauses,
- Use dictionaries to check spellings and meanings of words,
- Proof-read our work to check for spelling and grammar errors,
- Develop our ideas to engage and interest the reader,
- Use a variety of sentence lengths in our writing,
- Use rhetorical questions.

### Maths

We will be learning to;

- Add and subtract fractions with same denominator,
- Solve problems involving fractions to calculate quantities,
- Interpret and present data using bar charts and time graphs,
- Solve problems from bar charts, pictograms and tables,
- Divide a number by 10 and 100,
- Recap mental multiplication skills,
- Recap formal multiplication,
- Solve problems involving multiplying and adding,
- Solve measures problems,
- Read, write and convert time between 12 and 24 hour clocks,
- Solve problems converting between units of time,
- Complete a simple symmetric figure.



Children will also continue to learn their times tables in preparation for Hot-Seating & Time Table Rock Stars.

### Science Sound

Children will learn:

- To explore the relationship between distance and volume,
- that sounds are made when objects and materials vibrate,
- To investigate whether sound can travel through different materials,
- To investigate how sounds can be different pitches and volumes.

### Habitats

- To construct and interpret Food Chains,
- To group organisms according to their characteristics,
- To use classification keys,
- How habitats can change.
