

John Rankin Sport Premium Action Plan and Impact Statement 2020-21

As a Local Authority organisation, our federation is eligible for the Primary School Sport Funding Grant. JRS will receive £37,220 for the 2020-2021 academic year as well as £39,730 carried over from 2019/20. Total £76,950.

There are 5 key indicators we want to improvement across:

1. Ensure all children are returning swiftly to the national expectation of physical activity since their return from Lockdown.
2. Increased level of external companies, staff lead clubs or activities before, during or after-school, for all children across the whole federation; especially those who do not currently attend clubs, with many of them being non-fee paying.
3. Create class bubble PE packs of sports equipment, both indoor and out, in preparation for the continued need to sanitise equipment.
4. The implementation of a fully diverse PE curriculum with less common sports in primary schools and the UK, and to ensure the participation of ALL children daily running or walking activities on our new marked out tracks.
5. Ensure that we utilise the skills of the Head of PE from St Bart's, our new PE Technician and our PE Lead, with regards to our planning, preparation, teaching and assessment, while developing staff knowledge and confidence within the subject.
