- We use positive rewards in many forms:

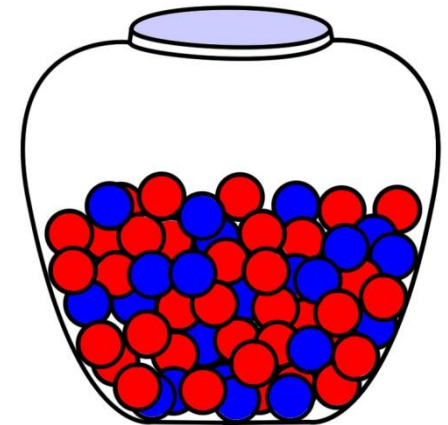
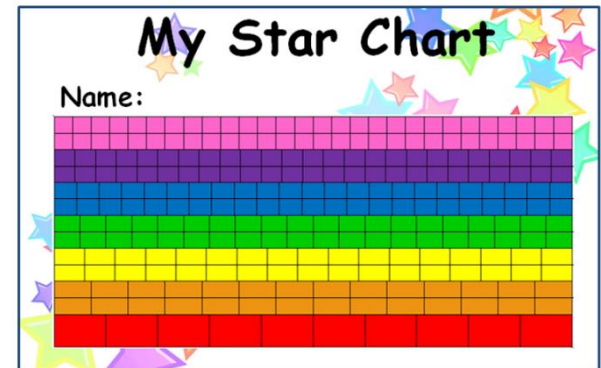
