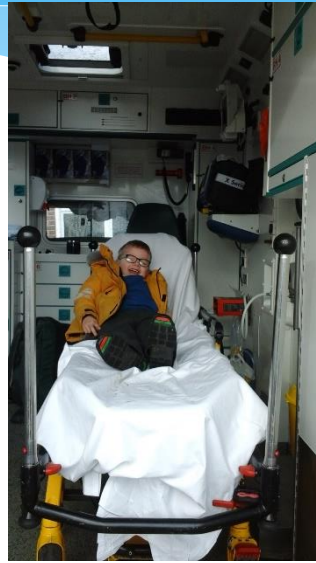

## Reading – FS2

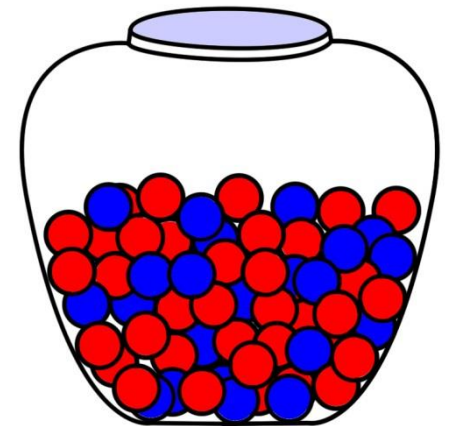
