


This is my new classroom...






Our classroom might be set out a bit differently than our old one. Sometimes we will be able to learn outside.

At lunchtime...






My adult will collect me at 3:10 and we will need to leave the school grounds following the one way system.

Year 1 - Helpful tips

READING

Children will independently change their reading books, every day if they need to. When they have finished their reading book either at school or at home they will return it and choose a new one that they like the look of.

Children should read for 10 minutes each night at home with you and you should leave a comment about how they got on in their reading record.

HOMEWORK

Learning tasks are posted in Google Classrooms every Friday at 3pm and should be completed by 9am on Wednesday mornings. You will received login details from the school office in due course. There will be tasks in maths and phonics and these will be differentiated to suit each learners needs. However, sometimes there may be other activities that will be sent via your book bag for example topic work or handwriting.

SPARE CLOTHES

Please send in a named bag with a spare set of clothes and underwear. We need them in case of toilet accidents or wet outdoor play. Children will keep these in a small bag on their peg.


Please send in a pair of wellies that can stay in school as we explore the secret gardens and grounds often during the week.



All the adults are very excited to welcome us all back to school!


We will have so much fun together in Holly class.
