English

During this term we will be covering these text genres;

We will be learning:

- Place value of numbers up to 4 digits

- Addition and Subtraction of four digit numbers with and without exchanging.

Children will also continue to practise times tables through the use of a range of teaching methods.

Touching on climate and landscape.

History

Learning about who the Ancient Greeks were and how they lived as well as famous ancient Greeks. Learning about different gods and goddesses as well as comparing the Ancient and Modern Olympic Games.

Children will learn about:

- The different characteristics of solids, liquids and gases.
- Materials that change state when they are heated or cooled.
- The effect of temperature on the rate of evaporation.
- The part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.
