During this term we will be covering these text genres:

We will be learning to;


- develop our use of complex sentences using a range of subordinating and co-ordinating conjunctions
- use inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate direct speech
- use commas accurately to mark clauses
- identify and use comparative and superlative adjectives
- add detail and interest (embellish) to simple sentences.
- use prepositional phrases to place the action
- identify and use figurative language



MATHS

We will be learning to;

- Recognise and use tenths, hundredths and thousandths and relate them to decimals
- Round any number up to 1 000 000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1000 and 10,000
- Read and write Roman numerals up to 1,000
- Add and subtract whole numbers with more than 4 digits, including using formal written methods and mental
- Multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000; use factors, multiples and known facts to solve problems
- Measurement and time: length, volume, perimeter and area, time.
- Statistics: interpreting charts, graphs, timetables and 2-way tables



AUTUMN TERM 1 - CHANGING MATERIALS

Science & Food Technology

Children will learn:

- Learn about solids, liquids and gases.
- Investigate what happens when you mix solids with liquids, and how to separate them.
- Investigate what happens when you heat solids.
- Learning about reversible and irreversible changes

AUTUMN TERM 1 - ANGLO SAXONS AND VIKINGS IN BRITAIN

History

Children will use and analyse sources of information to learn about:

- Settlement of Britain by Saxons and Vikings
- The structure of Anglo-Saxon society
- How Anglo Saxons lived their daily lives
- Alfred the Great and the resistance against Viking invasion
- Raider or trader: did the Vikings deserve their reputation?
- The Bayeux Tapestry & the Battle of Hastings.



Geography

Children will learn:

- The Anglo-Saxon invasions and the 7 kingdoms
- Counties of the UK and Anglo-Saxon place-names.

Charanga - music linked to theme

ART

Symbolism in Tudor portraits, creating our own versions and interpreting Shakespeare plays using a variety of media.

DT

Creating salt dough Anglo Saxon jewellery inspired by Sutton Hoo and Lindisfarne Gospels.

AUTUMN TERM 2 - TUDORS

History

Children will use a range of sources and visits to collect information about the past to learn:

- Voyages of exploration and colonisation in the New World
- The lives of some black people in Tudor England
